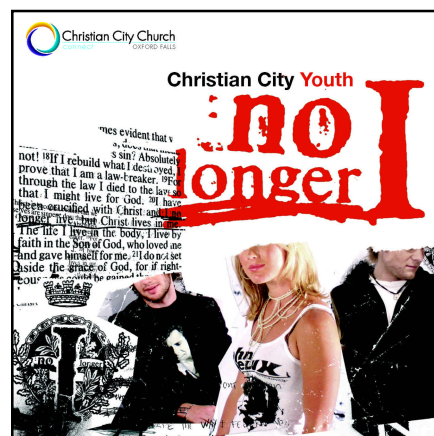


FRESH POP ROCK FROM Christian City Youth

MORE THAN – FIRST RADIO SINGLE

The first CHR/pop radio single from the album is *More Than*. This is all about letting go of your own life and hanging on to Jesus.

The enclosed pre-release singles disc includes several versions of *More Than*.

- Track 1 has a quick fade around 4:15s.
- Track 2 is around 3:25 and will probably suit most stations.
- Track 3 is a high energy short version for stations with a tight playlist and those requiring short songs for breakfast/drive airplay.
- Track 4 is the full version for night time airplay.
